This 12 day tour combines the best of Armenia and Georgia, two very different but equally rewarding countries. In both, you'll discover centuries-old monasteries in breathtaking locations, fascinating museums, characterful cities and of course a landscape that's as beautiful as it is varied. Taste Armenian brandy, learn how to bake lavash, explore underground cave cities, luxuriate in a thermal bath and visit a chaotic animal bazaar. Throughout, you'll receive a typically warm Caucasus welcome in a region where hospitality means so much more than just polite and efficient service.

ITINERARY

Day 1 - Yerevan

You'll arrive today in the Armenian capital Yerevan, where we've arranged a meet and greet at the airport. Transfer to the hotel and settle in to your accommodation. Overnight in Yerevan. (D)

Day 2 - Yerevan - Echmiadzin - Zvartnots - Yerevan

Yerevan is one of the world's oldest cities, older than Rome and London, making it a fascinating place to explore. We'll begin with a visit to the Matenadaran Library, one of the world's oldest repositories of Greek, Persian, and Arabic manuscripts, housing 17,000 rare texts. Afterward, we'll visit the impressive Cascade, a massive stairway offering breathtaking views of the city and Mount Ararat in the distance. Next, you'll tour the city's main sights, including Republic Square to see the Singing Fountains and the Genocide Memorial, dedicated to one of the most tragic chapters in Armenian history. Later, we'll make an excursion to the UNESCO-listed Armenian Catholic cathedral at Echmiadzin, dating from 303 AD, and to the ruins of Zvartnots. Overnight in Yerevan. (B, D)

Day 3 - Yerevan - Garni - Geghard - Yerevan

This morning we drive out to Garni. Stroll through the stunning Garni Gorge, known for its unique rock formations, often referred to as the "Symphony of Stones," and cross the 9th-century stone bridge over the Azat River to reach the pagan Temple of Garni. Originally built in the 1st century AD, the temple was destroyed by an earthquake in 1679 and later restored in the 1970s, staying true to its Greco-Roman architectural style. Nearby, visit the UNESCO-listed Geghard Monastery, named after the legendary lance that pierced Christ's body, which was kept here for centuries. The current complex dates back to the 13th century, though a monastery existed on this site much earlier. Afterward, we'll stop at a local house where you'll have the chance to help prepare lavash, the traditional Armenian bread. Overnight in Yerevan. (B, D)

Day 4 - Yerevan - Khor Virap - Noravank - Areni - Yerevan

Gregory the Illuminator introduced Christianity to Armenia, and Khor Virap Monastery is deeply connected to this important figure in Armenian history. Perched on a hilltop, the monastery offers panoramic views of Mount Ararat, a snow-capped peak in neighboring Turkey that holds deep symbolic meaning for Armenians. Continuing our journey, we'll visit Noravank, a stunning 12th-century monastery nestled within a dramatic gorge, framed by towering red rock cliffs. Afterward, we'll stop at the renowned Areni Winery, where Armenia's ancient winemaking traditions come to life. You'll have the opportunity to taste a selection of local wines, and perhaps purchase a bottle or two as a memento. Before heading back to Yerevan, we'll explore Bird's Cave, an archaeological site where artifacts from a prehistoric settlement were uncovered, revealing fascinating details about early life in the region. Overnight in Yerevan. (B, D)

Day 5 - Yerevan - Sevan - Dilijan - Haghpat - Armenian-Georgian border - Tbilisi

One of the largest high altitude freshwater lakes on the planet, Lake Sevan is considered the pearl of Armenia. Surrounded by mountains, it sits at 2000 masl and is overlooked by the charming Sevanavank Monastery. You'll have to climb lots of steps to reach the church and its khatchkhars - at this altitude, it's quite literally

breathtaking - but it's utterly worth it when you take in the panoramic views. From there we move on to what's dubbed "Armenian Switzerland" and have a city tour of the delightful Dilijan. En route to the Georgian border, we'll call in at Haghpat monastery, one of the largest religious, cultural and educational centres of mediaeval Armenia. Meet your Georgian guide on the Armenian-Georgian border and together drive to Tbilisi. Dinner and overnight stay in Tbilisi. (B, D)

Day 6 - Tbilisi

Today you'll get to know the charming Georgian capital, Tbilisi. Its compact old town makes exploring a pleasure. We'll tick off some of the main sights including the 13th century Methekhi church, 6th century Antchiskhati Church, 12th century Sioni cathedral and an ancient synagogue. Jumping on the cable car, we'll ascend to the imposing Narikala Fortress and look down over the city. Back at the bottom, we'll round off this introduction to Tbilisi with a visit to the Georgian National Museum and a stroll along bustling Rustaveli Avenue, the city's main drag. Overnight in Tbilisi. (B, D)

Day 7 - Tbilisi - Mtskheta - Kutaisi

Near Tbilisi you'll find its predecessor Mtskheta, the ancient capital and religious centre of Georgia. Two important, UNESCO-listed sites are on the itinerary: the 6th century Djvari church and the 11th century Svetitskhoveli Cathedral. You'll enjoy a fascinating guided tour of both locations. Afterwards, we drive three hours west to Kutaisi, Georgia's second largest city. Nearby, we'll show you around Prometheus Cave with its many stalactites and stalagmites. Overnight in Kutaisi. (B, D)

Day 8 - Kutaisi - Gelati - Bagrati - Akhaltsikhe

Early morning bazaars are an established part of life in the Caucasus region and we'll begin today watching the animal traders and farmers carrying out their business. Today's sightseeing kicks off properly at the Gelati Monastery and Academy Complex, which dates from the 12th century. Moving on, we'll tour Bagrati Cathedral, also UNESCO-listed. From there, we'll drive to our base tonight at Akhaltsikhe. Overnight in Akhaltsikhe. (B, D)

Day 9 - Akhaltsikhe - Vardzia - Rabati Fortress - Akhaltsikhe

The incredible cave city of Vardzia is the highlight of today's sightseeing programme. It dates from Georgia's Golden Age and the complex comprises an astounding 300 or so caves. They were used as churches, refectories, wine cellars and dwellings. As we tour the complex, you'll learn what it would have been like at the height of its popularity. Later, we'll stop off at Rabati Fortress where there's an excellent ethnographic museum to check out. Overnight in Akhaltsikhe. (B, D)

Day 10 - Akhaltsikhe - Borjomi - Gori - Tbilisi

This morning we'll set our sights on Gori, breaking the journey with a wander through Borjomi Park on the way. Gori's most famous former resident is none other than the notorious Soviet leader Joseph Stalin and the museum which tells the story of his life is sure to hold our attention. Near Gori is another great cave city. You'll have plenty of time to acquaint yourself with Uplistikhe cave city before we hit the road again, bound for Tbilisi. There, we'll enjoy a traditional dinner accompanied by singing and folk dancing. Overnight in Tbilisi. (B, D)

Day 11 - Tbilisi

Having ticked off the must-sees, this day is free for you to explore Tbilisi at your own pace. We'd recommend a visit to one of the city's atmospheric thermal baths. You'll spot their characteristic domes in several locations in the old town. There are plenty of excellent gift shops in which you can pick up a souvenir or perhaps you'll enjoy a leisurely coffee in one of Tbilisi's many lovely caff ©s. Overnight in Tbilisi. (B, D)

Day 12 - Tbilisi

This morning marks the end of your Caucasus adventure in Armenia and Georgia. You'll be picked up from the hotel for your airport transfer in good time to make your flight. (B)

Step 1 - Choose Your Holiday & Departure Dates

When booking by email or over the phone please confirm your personal details (full name and address), chosen tour, departure date, package type (hotel category), and available upgrades.

Step 3 - Confirmation of your booking

On receipt of your booking form, we will make any necessary reservations for you and send you confirmation invoice, including the flight details, and additional information about your destination: advice on visas, vaccinations and what to take. The invoice will also show you the exact due date of the payment.

Step 4 - Payment

Please note, if your departure date is more than 56 days you will need to pay the deposit, which should cover the full cost of the flight (if applicable), plus 10% of the land-only arrangements (minimum BJ100) per person towards your tour. The outstanding payment must be made 56 days prior to departure. If you book less than 56 days before departure, full payment must be made at the time of your booking. You can make your payment by bank transfer, debit or credit card, cheque, bankers draft or postal order. You will find all relevant payment details in your invoice.
